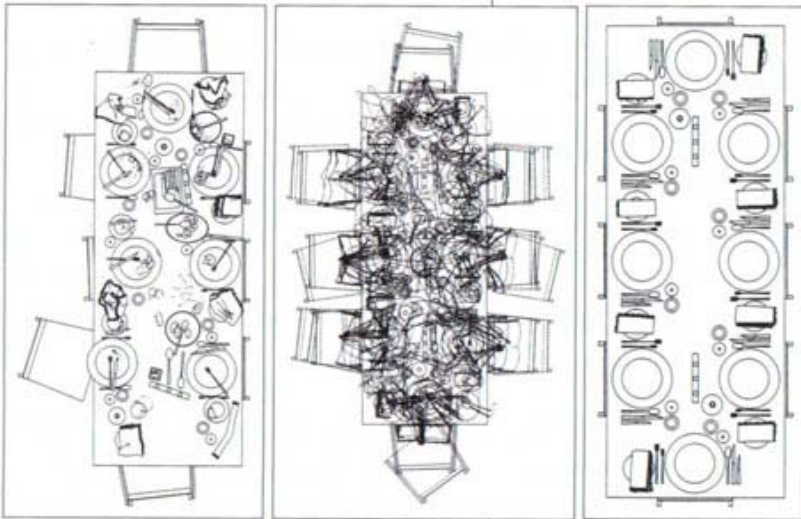


## COOKING SPACE

STUDENT PROFILE: BREAKFAST, LUNCH, DINNER OR A COCKTAIL?

What size is a kitchen, a dining room? How does the size of our body interact with these spaces? What are the dimensions of the body? What are the dimensions of the furniture? How are our positions different in space and time during breakfast (B), lunch (L), dinner (D) or a cocktail (C)?

Duchamp's *Nude descending a staircase* graphically explains how a body moves through **space** and **time**. The positions of the players of a football team change continuously throughout the game (we will see in class the PO2 video for the Venice Biennale 2002). The table settings change depending on whether we're having B, L, D or C, and it further changes during that repast.
